Buildings and Grounds Report

9/1/20 Vestry meeting

Completed:

- 1. Waterproofing work has been completed in the Ark. They discovered a second sump pump in the window well outside of the window. Now both pumps have been replaced and the wall has been sealed from the inside with a drainage trench along the wall. Terra Electric ran a dedicated line for the sump pumps to eliminate the use of extension cords. Terra also replaced a couple of dead outlets and added a couple of outlets for the new wall which Gus the mason built after finishing the trench work and wall sealing.
- 2. Rectory patio has been redone by Gus.
- 3. CB Cleaners did a thorough cleaning of the church. We should have them in at least 2-3 times a year for a deep cleaning.
- 4. Some of the organ pipes have been cleaned and wrapped to await reinstallation
- 5. Lock changed and door mechanism repaired for the Ark door at the bottom of the parking lot stair tower

Scheduled:

- 1. Gutter cleaning and repairs as needed
- 2. Rectory AC condensation line/drip pan repairs

Items to be revisited/restarted/added

- 1. Rectory beams (porch and courtyard side). Need to follow up with D Labrake)
- 2. Walkways (we have bids)
- 3. Parking lot repairs (a couple of potholes needing to be filled)
- 4. Replacing badly corroded steam pipes in the boiler room and undercroft (Will get Sheehan back on this)
- 5. Clearing out junk from the undercroft area as well as in Mark's office
- 6. Install fire dept knox box (I will take care of it). This is a special lockbox for fire and police to have emergency access to keys
- 7. Door from Lady Chapel to the courtyard is badly swollen/ deteriorating and the "modern" stained glass window (which has been cracked for many years) is buckling and falling out. A contractor is looking into it.
- 8. Kickplate on the door leading to the Sulgrave entrance needs to be repaired or replaced (it has a kick plate which is partially off and sticking out and the door itself is flimsy
- 9. There is a water hose bib in the courtyard which does not have a working shut off. It is currently being contained by a hose and nozzle. Sheehan will take care of this
