Buildings and Grounds Report

11/10/20 Vestry meeting

1. Snow removal contract has been accepted
2. Sheehan took care of replacing the rectory boiler condensation tank.
3. Sheehan did the pre-seasonal cleaning and servicing of both Rectory and Church boilers.
4. While servicing the smaller boiler (20 plus years old unit), they discovered that it was on its last legs and would have required \$500 or so in repairs to get it running. It was decided to not take a gamble and put good money into a unit which could possibly require more repairs later this year. Sheehan replaced the boiler with a new and more efficient one for \$6600. This small boiler heats parts of the Ark.
5. Gus did some wall repair work in the infant room.
6. Exterior flood lights are having some issues. Terra Electric is working on it.
7. Rectory kitchen door and door leading to Lady chapel are getting replaced by A 24 Hour Door. The doors are in. I am going to get him some paint so that we can have it painted close to what is there.
