1. Gus is going to build a new window well box and cover with flashing to go over the window well where we had issues during the ark flooding.
2. Ethan from 24 hour door took measurements of the Sulgrave entrance door. It will need to be custom made. They are working on a design and proposal to replace the door as well as the archway of windows surrounding the door. Stay tuned for the proposal.
