Buildings and Grounds Report

4/13/21 Vestry meeting

1. Joan Cesare had a carpenter she is using put together a proposal by Wally Manfredia to replace the sulgrave door.
2. Sheehan replaced a badly leaking water heater in the rectory. It was leaking water into the gas line/controller. Sheehan has also replaced some leaking pipes, clamped a few others and plans to replace them soon too.
3. We need to get eyes back on the repairs needed for the rectory porch beams as well as the beams outside of the rectory dining room. If possible, I would like for Rich to take this one on. I will put him in touch with Darrin Lebrake for starters.
4. Terra installed new lights at the rectory and foyer by the vesting sacristy.
5. The stained-glass window installation began on Saturday and continues through this week. They are aware of the funeral and service schedule.
6. Rectory chimney and fireplace work needed. Fr. Joel has the proposal.
7. Rectory garage door needs to be replaced. This is long overdue. Ethan from 24 hour door is scheduled to come out today or tomorrow to take measurements. I sent him photos. He roughly estimated that it would be around 1,500-1,800 because it is a custom size and will take a few weeks to order.
8. I also sent Ethan photos of the shed garage door which has been rotten for years. That is a stock size and would most likely run around 1,100.
