Buildings and Grounds Report

5/4/21 Vestry meeting

1. Waiting on status: Joan Cesare had a carpenter she is using put together a proposal by Wally Manfredia to replace the sulgrave door.
2. We need to get eyes back on the repairs needed for the rectory porch beams as well as the beams outside of the rectory dining room. If possible, I would like for Rich to take this one on. I will put him in touch with Darrin Lebrake for starters.
3. Rectory chimney and fireplace work completed. Fr. Joel wants it to be inspected to make sure it was done correctly
4. Rectory garage door needs to be replaced. Violette sent in the deposits so the doors can be ordered for both Rectory Garage and the shed
5. The Ark door's mechanical lock and controller need to be replaced. The original one is obsolete. The replacement unit has been ordered. Cost is \$4000.
6. Sheehan to be doing more pipe work in the basement of the church.
7. Waiting for the organ people to schedule the cleaning, refitting and tuning of the antiphonal pipes
